At Stubbins School, equality is a key principle for treating all people fairly and creating a society in which everyone has the opportunity to fulfil their potential - irrespective of their gender, ethnicity, disability, religion or belief, sexual orientation, age or any other recognised area of discrimination. Governor's meetings are held six times a year in the evenings and there are other responsibilities that may also require some time commitment. This voluntary role will require enhanced DBS clearance.
