It is with sadness that we heard of the death of Mrs. Lord, a former member of staff at Stubbins, on 12th April 2021 aged 79 years. She leaves her son, Richard, to whom we extend our deepest sympathy. Mrs. Lord was a most competent and reliable School Secretary at Stubbins for upwards of 25 years, spanning the headships of Mr. Longworth, Mr. Smith and Mr. Johnson (pictured).

Her husband, Ellis, died in 1999 and they had lived in the same house in Greenmount since their marriage 57 years ago. They loved travel and had been all over the world.
