Dear Parents & Friends,

Unfortunately, this week we had positive COVID-19 cases in school which resulted in us having to close down the Year 4 and Year 5 bubbles. These classes are now being taught online and will return to school on Monday 21st June. This has reminded us all that the pandemic is still with us and that although there is some promise of restrictions easing, we still need to be vigilant. To me, it feels more real now than ever, affecting more people we know on a local level.

The new variant seems to spread much more easily and the symptoms may simply be 'feeling unwell', 'a headache' or an 'upset tummy'. Rossendale has one of the highest infection rates in the country – higher than Bolton. Because of all these things, we need to reinforce the following messages:

- 1) **Please wear a face mask when entering school grounds.**
- 2) **Please keep your child at home if they are feeling at all unwell.**
- 3) **If anyone in your family has a cough, temperature, loss of taste or smell, an upset tummy or a headache which lasts longer than usual – get them to take a COVID test & follow the latest isolation guidelines.**
- 4) **Continue to wash hands regularly, wear a face mask and keep your distance.**
