Dear Parents and Friends,

Year 6 Leavers' Presentation

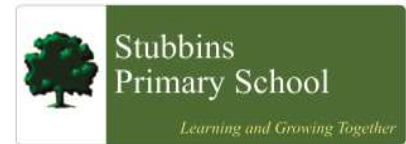
