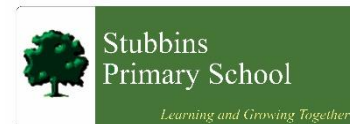


Stubbins Primary School

Concerns & Suggestions

- Information regarding Cancellation of events not given soon enough.
- I felt let down this year.
- Communication between school and home is a concern. (3)
- Text messages about events are too close to the event.
- My child feels lonely at school.
- More variety and quality needed in school meals and the hygiene of the tables is not good.
- Some children find Big Writing dull.
- School based before and after school clubs would help parents greatly. (2)
- There are very little photos/ videos of what classes are doing.
- ParentPay or some online payment system please.
- The high staff turnover in Year 2 this year is a concern. (2)
- There needs to be teachers at the gate or no parents on the playground.
- Would like to see more gardening.
- Handwriting. It is confusing that books are in print but handwriting is joined up.
- Could we have some commentary on Sports day next year please?

Headteacher's Response

I am generally extremely happy with the results of our parent questionnaire, with no more than 4% of parents disagreeing with any statement. Where there is a 'neutral' response, this is often because the parent has no experience with which to comment (for example the child may not be on school meals.)

The highest 'disagree' responses were in the following categories:

- **My child enjoys school. (3%)**
- **The school takes account of my suggestions and concerns. (4%)**
- **The school is led and managed effectively. (3%)**
- **The school communicates effectively. (4%)**

These were often linked and related to particular needs or situations. We do try very hard to meet the needs of all learners. Our aim is that every child should enjoy school, and although only 3% of children say they do not, this is still a concern. We will continue to work to make this 100% agree!

The school newsletter remains our primary means of communication re. school events. Text messages are used mainly for last minute reminders of where an event is suddenly cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control. The Newsletter is emailed to those who request it, posted on our website and made available in paper form in the foyer. Upcoming events are posted on the newsletter well in advance; initially in the 'Dates for your Diary' section. Class teachers generally have their own letters to parents which are sent out as required. If parents wish to discuss their child's progress at any time, our teachers are always ready to help.

The leadership and management of the school is the responsibility of Governors, the Headteacher and other senior staff and managers within the school. I would like to assure parents that we do take your feedback very seriously and that we will be looking at all the points raised to see how we can improve further. Thank you for your time in completing the questionnaire, and for your encouraging positive comments which are most pleasing.
