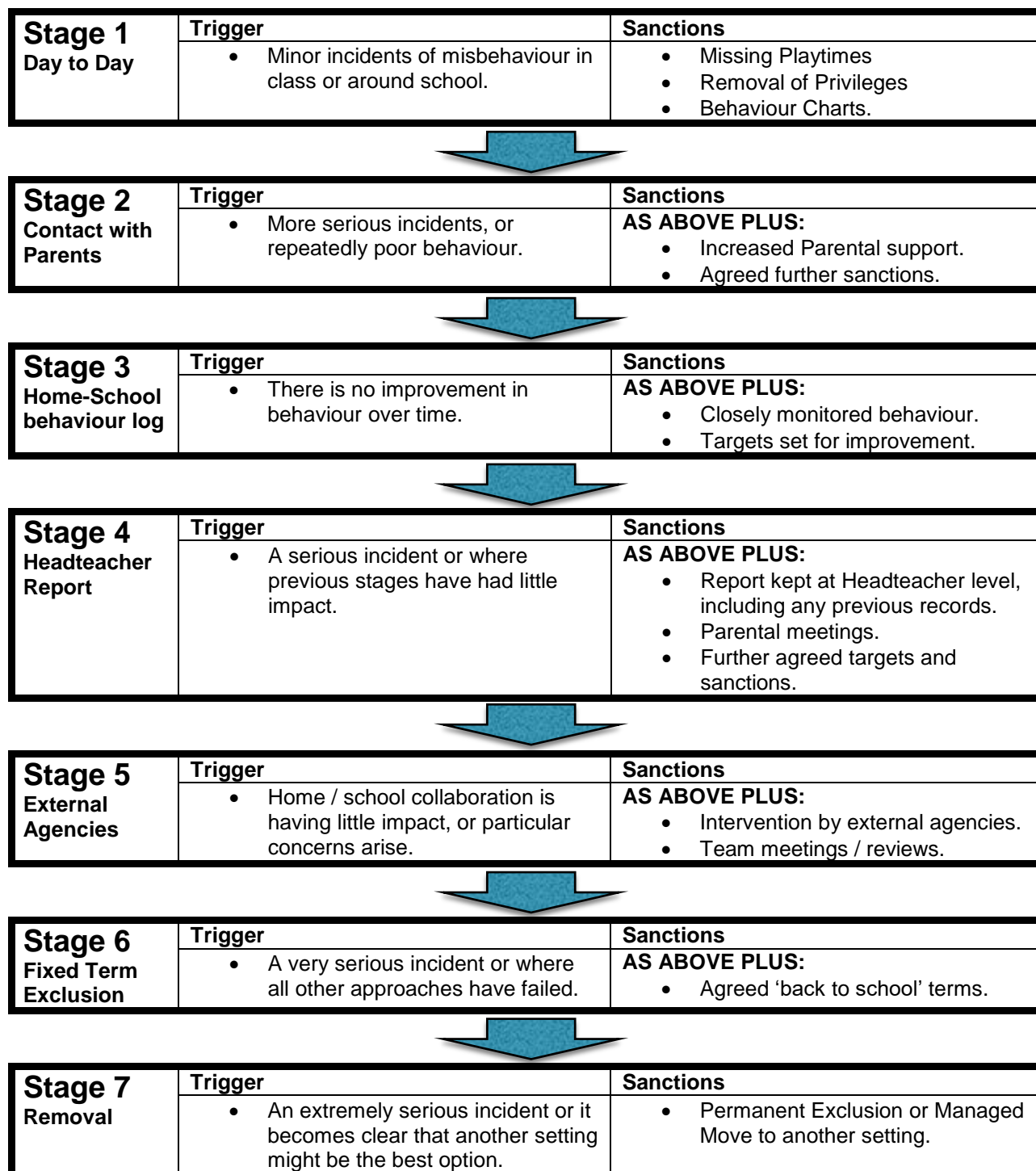


Stubbins Primary School Behaviour Policy Stages of Action

These are the stages which will apply when dealing with behaviour issues in school. Throughout the process, we will use Rewards as well as Sanctions, as stated in our Behaviour Policy. The vast majority of behaviour issues will be dealt with at stage 1. Some issues will require moving to stage 2 or 3. In rare and more serious cases, children will be on Headteacher Report at Stage 4. The help of external agencies may be sought (Stage 5). It is our aim to deal with all behaviour issues at school, but where necessary we may be forced into exclusion at Stage 6 or Stage 7.

Although we would normally use early intervention at the lower stages, it may be that an incident moves a child up several stages; e.g. A very serious assault may lead straight to Stage 6 exclusion.



Parents will be informed of any actions taken from Stage 2 onwards. This may be through verbal communication, meetings or an official letter. These stages of action may run alongside other policies such as Special Education Needs and the Lancashire Safeguarding Continuum of Need.
