Dear Parents and Friends,

With only a week before the summer holidays, preparations are well under way for September. I will be sending out more details of this next week.

## Year 6's Leaving Arrangements

It is the time of year again when we say goodbye to our Year 6 children, who are moving on to their High Schools. We very much regret that we have been unable to do the usual 'Leavers' production and activities. On the last day of term, we want to do something, but we are very much restricted by current regulations. I spoke to our Health & Safety Adviser this morning who reminded me that gatherings of more than 30 people are not permitted! So, after much discussion, this is what we are able to do:

- Year 6 Parents/ Carers (STRICTLY NO MORE THAN 2 PEOPLE PER CHILD - INCLUDING ANY SIBLINGS) are invited to collect their child at 2pm on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July.
- Upon arrival, please stand at the edges of the playground, observing 2 metres distance between families.
- The Year 6 children will come out of school to join you.
- Before you leave, we will present the awards and records of achievement and wish you well for your future.
- The children will go back into class to collect their belongings.
- Parents are then invited to wait, 2metres apart, down the driveway.
- The children will leave from the front entrance and down the steps, when they will be applauded as is our tradition here at Stubbins.

Although this is not as much as we can usually offer, I hope that it gives the children an appropriate moment of closure before moving on. **Please do not ask if more than two people can attend – the answer will be no. If the rules are broken, and a large number arrive, I will cancel the presentation.**

## Summer Holidays

We have had confirmation that we will not be open during the summer holidays. School closes to all children on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July at 3:15pm. **School re-opens on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September, when we will welcome all our children from Year 1 to Year 6 back into school.** Our Reception children will be starting on a part-time basis at first. There will be some changes to drop-off and pick-up times, school organisation and routines. We will implement class sized bubbles, as well as encouraging staff and pupils, where they are able, to keep their distance from each other and avoiding touching.
