The Royal British Legion Poppy Appeal

Remembrance Sunday is on Sunday 8th November. The usual Church Service is obviously cancelled, but Mr Dunne, one of our Governors, has enlisted the help of Mrs Parrish to create a short Remembrance video, which will be available to view on the Philip Dunne Facebook Page from 9am on Sunday. Armistice Day is commemorated every year on 11 November to mark the armistice signed between the Allies of World War I and Germany at Compiègne, France at 5:45 am, for the cessation of hostilities on the Western Front of World War I, which took effect at eleven o'clock in the morning—the "eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month" of 1918. We shall be observing a minutes silence on the 11th at 11 o'clock. Poppies would usually have been sold in school in aid of the Poppy Appeal, but sadly this was not possible.
