### Reducing Anxiety in Children: A Brief Group Intervention for Parents

Manchester University are doing some research with parents of primary school children. The aim of these sessions is to help you understand and manage your child's feelings of anxiety. Several parents have signed up, and there are new spaces now available.

#### Who can participate?

- Parents of children who are experiencing anxiety, aged between 5-11 years.
- You will need an electronic device with access to the internet.
- Either one parent or both parents can volunteer.
- You will be asked to complete an online questionnaire to see if you are suitable for the study.
- The study will involve attending online interactive group sessions and completing some questionnaires during each session.
- You may also be asked to take part in an interview.
- Parents who attend all sessions will receive a £10 voucher as a 'thank you' for taking part.
