Christmas Track & Trace

Dear Parent / Carer & Members of Staff,

School closes for the Christmas Holiday at the end of the school day on Friday 18th December.

If a pupil or staff member develops COVID-19 symptoms within 48 hours of finishing for the Christmas **Holiday (i.e. before 3:30pm on Sunday 20th December)**, school **MUST** be informed immediately via email using the address head@stubbins.lancs.sch.uk

The pupil or staff member **MUST** then be tested for COVID-19, and school **MUST** be informed of the result as soon as it is received using the same email head@stubbins.lancs.sch.uk

If the test comes back positive for COVID-19, school will inform all pupils and staff in that 'bubble' to self-isolate for 14 days since the point of last contact.

Where a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, (i.e. after 3:30pm on Sunday 20th December) the school should not be contacted.

Children return to school on Tuesday 5th January. Any pupil who has COVID-19 symptoms, or who has tested positive for COVID-19 should remain at home and school must be contacted.
